I am requesting funding for the Grant Line Road Safety and Freight Mobility Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Capital SouthEast Connector Joint Powers Authority, located at 2729 Prospect Park Drive, Rancho Cordova, CA 95670.

The funding would be used to reconstruct 3.6-miles of existing Grant Line Road into a four-lane divided complete street corridor with a separated Class I bike path in the City of Rancho Cordova and Sacramento County. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project is a component of the 34-mile Capital SouthEast Connector (Connector), a Multimodal Corridor that is part of the National Highway System, linking Interstate 5 (I-5), State Route 99 (SR-99), and US Highway 50 (US-50). These three highways are the main arteries for carrying people and freight throughout the state. The Connector project provides parallel capacity, increasing mobility in the region and reducing congestion on these three major highways.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
