I am requesting funding for the Sacramento Region Critical Safety Infrastructure in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Sacramento Regional Transit District, located at 1102 Q Street, Suite 4100 Sacramento CA 95811.

The funding would be used to replace and construct critical safety infrastructure in disadvantaged communities across the Sacramento region. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the improvements will modernize outdated lighting systems at 10 SacRT light rail stations and 6 park and ride lots—locations that serve thousands of riders who rely on safe, reliable transit access.
