I am requesting funding for the Sacramento Workforce-Led Transitional Housing Development Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Sacramento, located at 915 I St, Sacramento, CA 95814.

The funding would be used for development of a workforce-led transitional housing project located within California's 6th Congressional District. The project will develop approximately 10-12 small-footprint housing units to provide safe, stable housing for low-income and disadvantaged residents. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will also contribute to broader community outcomes by reducing barriers to employment, increasing economic mobility, and supporting safer, more stable neighborhoods.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
