I am requesting funding for the Statewide and Regional Active Shooter and Student Rescue Training Facility project in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Sacramento County Sheriff's Office located at 4500 Orange Grove Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95841. The project is located at 12500 Bruceville Road, Elk Grove, CA 95757.

The funding would be used for construction of a regional active shooter and student rescue facility that would include several mock-up structures to resemble various training situations.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would offer a training facility solely dedicated to active shooters or human trafficking rescue operations to co-train federal, state, or local law enforcement officers. Expanding training resources will improve community safety for our region.
