Dear Speaker Boehner and Leader Pelosi:

Last year, Congress overwhelmingly passed a version of the No Budget, No Pay Act. This was a good first step, but it was only a temporary restriction. We need a permanent bill to require Congress to fulfill its most basic responsibilities: passing a budget and appropriations bills on time.

A year has passed, and Congress has made some progress. Both the House and Senate passed budgets last year. This proves pay for performance works. But we have much more progress to make. Congress still has not adopted a budget conference report in more than 1,700 days. And it's now been 17 years since all appropriations bills were passed on time. These continued failures are inexcusable. We know what works, and we should continue holding Congress' feet to the fire.

No Budget, No Pay can't be a one-year experiment; it should be made permanent. The bipartisan, bicameral No Budget, No Pay Act introduced last year by Jim Cooper, Reid Ribble, Ami Bera, and Ron DeSantis with our colleagues Sens. Dean Heller (R-NV) and Joe Manchin (D-WV) is permanent. The No Budget, No Pay Act, H.R. 310, also says that if Congress doesn't pass its budget and all appropriations conference reports by October 1st every year, then Congress doesn't get paid. Once pay is withheld, it's gone for good.

Getting the job done on time is a fundamental American principle, yet one that has been forgotten in our nation's Capitol. Americans work hard for their paychecks, and so must Congress. Members of Congress shouldn't be getting paid if they can't do their work. Bottom line: no budget, no pay. No appropriations bills, no pay. It's that simple.

We respectfully urge you to bring H.R. 310 to the floor for a vote as soon as possible, and look forward to working with you on this critical reform. Thank you for your consideration.


