I am requesting funding for the Bohemian Park Community Center - Resilience Wing project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Fulton-El Camino Recreation and Park District located at 2201 Cottage Way, Sacramento, CA 95825.

The funding would be used for the construction of a 3,000 square foot Resilience Wing for the Bohemian Park Community Center, located in an under resourced neighborhood, that would provide classroom space for year-round education and workforce training and additional community gathering spaces. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would serve as a community hub in a low-income census tract and offer economic and education opportunities for a growing immigrant population.
